SYSTEMS OF CONTROLS

01

Minimising contact with those who are unwell

Those who have symptoms, or who have someone in their household who does, don't attend nursery. If a child is unwell they must be collected within 30 minutes.

02

Use of face coverings

Our practitioners will wear face masks and visors when children arrive or leave the nursery. They will also wear face masks when using communal areas of the nursery. They will not wear masks when working with your child during their sessions

03

Handwashing

Our routines include regular hand washing when entering the nursery, before & after certain activities, before eating, after using the toilet, after being outside and before handwashing.

04

Good respiratory hygiene

We promote the 'Catch it, bin it, kill it' approach with children and adults in the nursery. Children and staff wash hands if they sneeze or cough on them.

05

Enhanced cleaning

We continue our enhanced cleaning procedures including regular cleaning of high touch points. We have removed toys, resources and soft furnishings that are not easy to keep clean.

06

Appropriate PPE

Only regular PPE is worn unless staff welcome families at the gate or care for a child with symptoms of coronavirus. Staff will occasionally wear additional PPE when nappy changing.

07

Minimising contact between groups

We have three room bubbles. Each bubble has their own toilets, changing area and space to play in the garden. Staggered drop off and pick up times will continue to reduce mixing of families from different bubbles. Each bubble has it's own door to use when entering and exiting the nursery building.
